

KICKBALL RULES

- ◆ Kickball is similar to baseball except the pitcher rolls a soccer or playground ball from the pitcher's mound to a player who kicks the ball from home plate.
- ◆ Make equal teams and divide the better players between the teams.
- ◆ Runners must touch each base with their foot.
- ◆ When the pitcher bounces the ball at the mound after a kick by the kicker, any runner who is not in contact with a base must return to the base they just passed. If the kicker hasn't reached 1st base yet, they are out.
- ◆ No arguing about a call—PLAY FAIR.
- ◆ A runner who is struck by the ball below the waist is out.
- ◆ If the ball makes contact with the base (bounce it on the base), the runner coming to that base is out.
- ◆ A caught fly ball is an out.
- ◆ A tie always goes to the runner (if the runner and ball get to the base at the same time).
- ◆ Each team has 3 outs and then the other team goes up.
- ◆ 3 strikes and you're out.
- ◆ Foul balls count as strikes for strikes one and two, but not for strike three.
- ◆ A ball kicked into foul territory is a foul.
- ◆ A ball kicked fair that rolls foul before 1st or 3rd base is foul.
- ◆ A ball kicked fair that rolls foul after 1st or 3rd base is a fair ball.
- ◆ Be polite and respectful—no swearing, put-downs, yelling, bragging, etc.
- ◆ No stealing bases.
- ◆ No bunting.
