Lunch Options for Grades 3-5 begin Monday!

Starting February 1, 2010, our school will be starting a pilot program for grades 3-5 which will offer two different choices to have that day for hot lunch. We plan to offer the choices to grades 1-2 shortly afterward.

How it will work:

Teachers will ask students in the morning whether they are having hot lunch and which of the two items they want. The count will be passed on to the kitchen and the students meals will be made as requested. Once a student has made a choice in the morning, they will not be able to change options.

There are two BIG events going on with the CHE PTA this month:

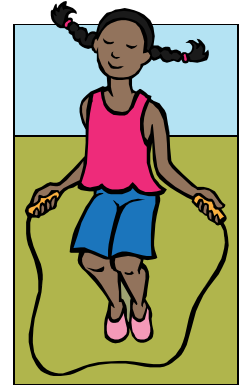
Beginning Monday, February 1, we have another Box Tops drive. The three classes who bring in the most Box Tops will earn Smencils!!!
