Check Out Our Rain Garden!

Mrs. Cane's 3rd grade portion of her 2/3 split class have been busy all year learning about, planning and building a "rain garden" with the help of a local engineer and a grant from the Oak Harbor Education Foundation, plus lots of help from local businesses.

A rain garden is a functional garden which is planted next to a parking lot. When it rains, water that normally just goes into the storm drain and out to Puget Sound carrying dirt, oil and other fluids from cars, flows into the rain garden instead. The garden, which is full of native plants and composted soils, holds and filters the water for a time, thereby cleaning it before it goes into the storm drain and out to the Sound.
