UNIFORM DESCRIPTION

Bottoms: Pants or capri pants (dark navy blue or khaki/ twill or corduroy) No Jeans, Denim, or Cargo pants

Walking Shorts or Skort: Must be fingertip length or longer (dark navy blue or khaki/ twill or corduroy) No Jeans or Denim

Jumper or Skirt: Must be fingertip length or longer (dark navy blue, khaki (twill or corduroy) or Black Watch plaid.

Shirts: Short or long sleeve (polo type with collar) turtle neck or mock turtleneck (solid dark navy blue, forest green or white) No button down shirts or blouses.

Outerwear: Sweater, fleece, plain sweatshirt, or OHE sweatshirt for inside or outside (navy blue, forest green, Black Watch plaid or white)

Socks: Tights, leggings, short/knee socks (ONLY white, navy, forest green or khaki solid color).

NO multi-colored socks, leggings or tights.

Shoes: Recommend solid color. NO flip-flops, heels, or platform shoes.
Heelies with wheels may not be worn.
Tennis shoes MUST be worn for PE class.

Coats: Recommend and prefer no logos.

All clothing needs to be marked with child's first and last name.

Oak Harbor Elementary Uniform Selection

OFFICIAL Uniform

This will be used for special occasions, concerts, and field trips, but may also be used everyday.

NEEDED:

One pant, skirt, or Jumper: dark navy blue, twill or corduroy only

One shirt: white

Outerwear (Optional) dark navy blue, forest green or white

EVERYDAY Uniform

This will consist of any of the following combinations.

NEEDED:

Pant, capri, walking short or skort: dark navy blue, khaki in twill or corduroy only

Jumper or Skirt: dark navy blue, khaki (twill or corduroy only) or Black Watch plaid

Shirts: solid dark navy blue, forest green, or white

Outerwear (optional): dark navy blue, forest green, or white

UNIFORM SPECIFICS

- Khakis should be tan, not brown or gray
- No oversized clothing—baggy or saggy
- No Jeans, Denim or Cargo pants
- Shorts, jumpers, skorts and skirts should be at least finger tip length or longer
- Solid color turtle necks, mock turtlenecks or polo type shirts only (No blouses or t-shirts)
- Layered/undershirts need to be uniform
- No Heelies with wheels
- Coats and other non-uniform outerwear may not be worn in the building.
- Scout uniforms may be worn the day of Scout meetings. No football, soccer, baseball uniforms
- Logos (other than OHE) are not allowed on any part of the uniform
- No hats may be worn inside

If your child is out of compliance with OHE's uniform policy one or more of the following steps will be taken:

1. The parents will be sent a warning note and uniform policy.
2. Parents will be contacted and may need to bring appropriate uniform to school.
3. The school will supply the child with an appropriate uniform.
4. All uniforms issued are expected to be returned to the school clean the next day.
