Ideas for Questions to Ask

- What activities does your school offer to students coming for a campus visit?
How do I make arrangements?
- What extracurricular programs are available on campus?
- What is the typical class size on campus?
- Are classes typically taught by graduate assistants, or are most taught by professors?
- Tell me about your school's Freshman Orientation Program.
- What types of dormitories (residence halls) does your campus have? What types of options does the food service program have on campus?
- What types of living options are offered in the various halls?
- What are the policies in place regarding drinking in the residence halls?
- Are there any halls with "quiet floors"?
- Does your campus offer an honors program? How does a student apply?
- Describe the geographical setting of the school and the community it's in.
- How safe is your campus? Are there programs developed to raise student awareness of safety issues?
- How does one go about getting involved in student government on campus?
- What is the name of the school newspaper, and how often is it published?
- What kinds of weekend activities are offered to students?
- Are financial aid packages offered by your school need-based?
- What is the average financial aid package offered to students?
- What does your campus offer to students that makes it stand out amongst the others?
- Does your campus have an early decision admission process? Is it binding?
- Does your campus have an early action process? What dates are involved?
- Does your campus offer housing options to students who wish to stay on campus during breaks?
- What types of jobs are available on campus or around the community?
- Tell me about your various sports programs.
