_____ **Tab # 1: Student as a Planner (5 points possible) Examples include:**

- Activities or classes you have taken which helped develop career goals
- Plans made and actions taken to apply to college/tech school/military or job for after high school

_____ **Tab # 2: Student as a Learner (5 points possible) Examples include:**

- Learning Style Survey results
- Career research/exploration
- Academic or Aptitude Test results
- Learning samples
- Personal samples

_____ **Tab # 3: Student as an Employee (5 points possible) Examples include:**

- Career Exploration Opportunities (CEO)
- Part-time work/internship or activity
- Attendance history
- Employment strengths and weaknesses

_____ **Tab # 4: Student as Citizen (5 points possible) Examples include:**

- What have you done as a volunteer?
- What have you done to make our school, school district or community a better place?
- What activities have you been involved in at school?

_____ **Summary (5 points possible) Examples include:**

- What positive characteristics describe you?
- What do you hope to contribute to society after high school?
- What do you hope to be remembered for?

Presentation Delivery Points (10 points possible)

- _____ **9-10 points:** Presentation is clearly organized with an introduction, body, and conclusion. Presentation utilizes an outline or note cards and the speaker effectively uses voice, eye contact, posture, and gestures to positively communicate with and involve the audience. Speaker's clean, neat, business appearance adds to the presentation.
- _____ **7-8 points:** Ineffective, inconsistent use of voice, eye contact, or personality. Demonstrates a lack of audience awareness. Speaker's appearance is appropriate.
- _____ **0-6 points:** Speech is read with little or no use of eye contact, voice, etc., to make contact with the audience. Speaker's appearance is distracting and/or inappropriate.

Presentation Creativity Points (10 points possible)

- _____ **10 points:** Presentation includes several visual aids such as props, examples, PowerPoint, illustrations, transparencies, copies of samples, etc. Student also further discusses their pathway (occupational, academic, military, artistic, etc.), activities and volunteer involvement, and/or displays special skills or projects.
- _____ **7-8 points:** Presentation is organized and has 1-2 visual aides, but does not fully utilize the resources available.
- _____ **0-6 points:** Student completes the minimum and presentation lacks effective use of visual aids.
