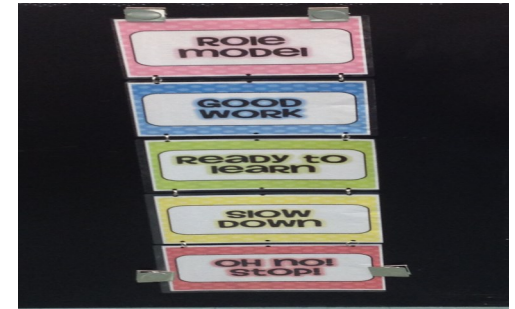

## Behavior Management



In my class we use a clip up and clip down chart.

**Ready to Learn:** Where every child starts the day.

**Good Work:/Role Model:** When a child is doing great, they will clip up.

**Slow Down:** If a child needs a second reminder about following rules, they will move their clip down.

**Oh no, Stop:** If a child needs another reminder they will move their clip to

**Oh no, Stop** and will be sent to processing.

**Processing:** A time for a child to reflect on behavior. Two trips to processing in one week will be lunch detention; three in one week is after school detention.

**Children always have the opportunity to change behavior and clip up during the day! ☺**

# Homework

Homework should be no more than 30 minutes each night. It will be sent home in a packet on Monday and will be due on Friday. The packet will consist of the following:

**Reading Log:** Please have your child read 20 minutes each night and record the name of the book.

**Math:** Math facts and/or skills practice.

If you would like to do more than what is assigned you are welcomed to do that, however, I value your family time and keep homework to a minimum.
