Course Description:

The Symphonic Band is our mid-level band class. Students learn a variety of music and music literacy skills. This class competes at band contest. Symphonic Band combines with the other band classes to form the marching band for parades. Symphonic Band students are invited, but not required, to participate with pep band. This class has required after-school performances.
