<p><a href="#"><u>ADVANCED PLACEMENT</u></a></p> <p><b>LOCATION: OHHS CAMPUS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Accelerated course work.</li> <li>• Qualified students may enroll and complete college level work to prepare for nationally scored test.</li> <li>• High school credit available with passing grade regardless of test score.</li> <li>• College credit and/or higher course level placement dependent on AP exam score and specific college policies.</li> <li>• Availability of Advanced Placement classes varies each year. Check the course guide for specifics.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enroll in Advanced Placement class at the high school.</li> <li>• Review and submit AP scores to appropriate school to qualify for college credit or placement.</li> </ul>
<p><b>COLLEGE DUAL CREDIT</b></p> <p><b>LOCATION: OHHS CAMPUS</b></p> <p><a href="#"><u>SEE COLLEGE DUAL CREDIT CHART</u></a></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows students to earn college credit for certain career/technical classes taken at high school.</li> <li>• Earn both high school and college credit with a grade of B or better</li> <li>• Earn college credit for free (or nominal fee) rather than paying full price of tuition.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enroll in Dual Credit designated classes at the high school</li> <li>• Register with college for dual credit.</li> <li>• Earn a B or better in course to demonstrate college-level competency.</li> <li>• Pay fee for colleges that require it to receive credit.</li> <li>• Request college transcript be sent to appropriate college or university.</li> </ul>
<p><a href="#"><u>COLLEGE IN THE HIGH SCHOOL</u></a></p> <p><b>LOCATION: OHHS CAMPUS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows sophomore, junior, and senior students to earn college credit from Central Washington University through selected high school courses.</li> <li>• Guaranteed university credit when course is passed.</li> <li>• Earn both high school and college credit at the same time.</li> <li>• Pay significantly reduced tuition fee per course vs. full university tuition.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enroll in courses that are approved for College in the High School.</li> <li>• Follow prerequisite information for eligibility.</li> <li>• Meet registration deadlines.</li> <li>• Pay course fees.</li> <li>• Request college transcript be sent to appropriate college or university.</li> </ul>
<p><a href="#"><u>RUNNING START</u></a></p> <p><b>LOCATION: SKAGIT VALLEY COLLEGE</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows qualified high school juniors and seniors to attend college classes.</li> <li>• Earn both high school and college credit at the same time.</li> <li>• Full-time Running Start students may qualify to complete an Associate's Degree at the same time they graduate high school.</li> <li>• No tuition costs - student only pays for course fees, textbooks and provides their own transportation.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meet with high school counselor in spring to start enrollment process.</li> <li>• Meet application and registration deadlines.</li> <li>• Verify that credits taken at college satisfy high school graduation requirements.</li> <li>• Make an extra effort to communicate with the high school regarding graduation requirements, deadlines, and other activities.</li> </ul>
