Course Name: Naval Science Drill and Rifle

Course Description:

Students will develop the skills needed to perform on the Oak Harbor Armed, Unarmed, Color Guard and Marksmanship teams. Students will learn the basic and exhibition phases of drill as well as standing Personnel Inspections. The exhibition phase is similar to the routines performed by the dance team, but with a military flavor and precision. The Marksmanship Team will complete a standard safety exam and then learn the art of shooting in the prone, standing and kneeling positions of both Sporter and Precision Air Rifle. All teams will compete against other schools within the Division and attempt to qualify for Regionals.
